



## 2022 Ministry of Education(MOE) Special Project Fee-Paying Chinese Language Program

- **Program:** PU Physical Fee-Paying Chinese Language Program
- **Targets:**
  1. Students from partner universities who are interested in learning Mandarin Chinese Language at Providence University(PU).
  2. Students with beginning to advanced level are both welcomed.
- **Requirements:**
  1. Take a Chinese language course: 15 credits/per week
  2. Study Length: the minimum 6 months (i.e.22 weeks)
- **Program Fee:** NT\$26,500 (22 weeks)
- **Nomination Deadline:** **January 25(Tues), 2022**
- **Application Deadline:** **January 28(Fri.), 2022**

- **Student is also responsible for:**
  1. Visa Application Fee (Before coming to Taiwan; visa type: FR visa)
  2. Flight Tickets
  3. Negative PCR Test Result (within 3 days valid before departure)
  4. 14-day Quarantine Plus 7-day Self-Health Management (accommodation & meals)
  5. 1<sup>st</sup> PCR Test upon Arrival at Taoyuan International Airport(TPE)
  6. 2<sup>nd</sup> PCR Test on the 12<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> Day of Quarantine
  7. Home Kit for PCR Test on the 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> Day of the Self-Health Management
  8. ARC Card Fee (after arriving at Taiwan)
  9. Fee for On-Campus Dormitory (reservation required& Bedding Set (available upon arrival)
  10. Field Trips (if any)
  11. Personal Living Expenses



● **Estimate Cost for Quarantine & Self-Health Management and Relevant Cost:**

● **Benefits:**

1. Partially tuition waived: As PU's partner university, partial tuition of the Chinese language courses is waived.
2. Enroll in academic courses: Except for learning the Chinese language, international students can take 1-2 academic courses at PU (Each course may be 2 or 3 credits).
3. Transcript and completion certificate will be issued after finishing the program.

● **Estimate Timeline to Join the Program:**

-Before February 14: PU needs to submit the applicant's list to MOE, Taiwan for approval.

-Feb.14-March 1: Students may start to apply for **FR visas** at Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office in their home country.

-After March 1: Students can enter Taiwan once having got the visas and bought their flight ticket.
