Transcript offered

The original transcript will be sent to the international office of the home University when students finish their study in DCU.

REGULATIONS FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

- Exchange students shall pay tuition at their home institution and then have the tuition waived at the host institution.
- Exchange students shall agree to abide by all the rules and regulations of the host institution and host country.
- Each application should be approved and sent with the officiation nomination le tter by the international office of the home university. The application materials fr om the applicants themselves will not be accepted.
- We are going to issue the <Letter of Invitation> and <Certifcate of Admission> after receiving the original copy of the application material.
- The host institution shall provide exchange students with academic guidance, counseling, and student support services.



REQUIREMENTS

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Daegu Catholic University has a great strength in teaching Korean for foreign students, so we want students who can understand basic level Korean Language. (Having a TOPIK Certificate is optional), We have only a few classes that are taught in English(Hospitality & Tourism).

HEALTH INSURANCE

According to the Health Insurance policy, all exchange students must have National Health Insurance in Korea.

To apply the national health insurance, you need to get an alien registration card first. Until You receive your alien registration card, you have to buy private health insurance.

- Private health insurance for 6 months: around 70,000KRW
 * Full coverage from the day you enter into Korea till you leave korea
 - * COVID-19 and non-covered details of National Health Insurance will be covered.
- * You should pay the fee only for 10a20% of out-of-pocket expenses

When an alien registration card will be issued, National Health Insurance will be automatically insured.

- National Health Insurance: about 38,000KRW per month
 - * You will receive a guide separately for insuring National Health Insurance.

VISA

Exchange students should apply for the D-2-6 Visa(Visa for exchange student) at the Consulate of Korea in each country with <Certificate of Admission> and <Letter of Invitation> issued by Daegu Catholic University and other documents which is required.

The most important documents are <Certificate of Admission> and <Letter of I nvitation>. DCU will send the original copy after reviewing students' application documents.

- * Spring Semester 2024: November 24th, 2023
- * Fall Semester 2024: May 24th, 2024

Application material should be arrived by the deadline.

 - vAffidavit of Financial Support (Korean or English)
 - **Consent form to release personal information**
- 2. Official Transcript (English)
- 3. Certificate of Enrollment (English Apostille)
- 4. Letter of Recommendation (Korean or English)
- 5. A copy of the student ID Card(in-home university)
- 6. A copy of the first page of Passport
- 7. 3 photographs (3x4cm size) white background
- 8.Certificate of Language Proficiency (TOPIK, TOEFL, etc)
- 9. Financial Guarantor's Certificate of Bank Balance (more than 8 million KRW per a semester)

- Spring semester: Beginning of March ~ End of June
- Fall semester: Beginning of September ~ End of December
