Woosong University is a specialized university, providing a curriculum based on practice and theory. The University has been ranked as an autonomous, top-tier university by the Korean Ministry of Education. It currently boasts multiple international schools:

SolBridge International School of Business,

Endicott College of International Studies, and JW Kim College of Future Studies.

Education in International schools is conducted solely in English by renowned international professors. In addition, we have four Korean schools including College of Railroad Transportation, College of Digital Media, College of Hotel and Culinary, and College of Health and Welfare. Since the establishment of the university in 1995, Woosong University has signed more than 400 Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) with universities and institutions in more than 60 countries. Collaborative programs include joint research, dual degree, Student Exchange, and Study Abroad among other programs.





Dormitory

Depending on the availability, students can stay at share a double bedroom provided by the university. The fee for the dormitory includes one meal per day. The dorm costs about USD 1350/ semester including one meal per day and there's no additional charge for utilities.

Off-campus Apartments

Exchange, Study Abroad, and Master dual degree students can also opt for off-campus apartments if they prioritize privacy and flexibility in their daily schedule. Apartments in Daejeon start at USD 300/ month depending on the size and location, excluding utilities.

General Living Expenses

Meals in South Korea are generally very affordable. Meals at the school cafeteria cost around 6 USD. Meals outside campus may range from 5 to 12 USD. Personal expenses depend upon the student's lifestyle. The school recommends students to plan monthly living expenses around USD 450 – 500.

Arrival Notes

All arriving students are expected to do 2 weeks of mandatory quarantine upon arrival. For students who opt for dormitory residence, the university charges about USD 450 for room and basic meals three times per day. During the quarantine, students will not be sharing rooms with anyone. Upon passing the quarantine process, students will be moved to a shared room.

Exchange students do not pay our university's tuition but they're responsible for other administrative fees to the university:



Dual Degree Students*

Depending on the university agreement, BBA dual degree students are expected to pay for the first-semester tuition with the following fee structure:

Insurance USD 50
Activity Fee USD 150
Orientation fee USD 150
Dormitory USD 1350 (only for students who live in the dormitory)
First-semester tuition before scholarship: USD 5500 (subject to change)

The scholarship will be in the form of tuition deduction (discount) and it is valid for the first semester.



- Essay




